a juried show

We invite you to participate in our 22nd annual Little Compton Summer Art Show at the Little Compton Community Center. Proceeds from the show will be used to benefit the many programs at the Center, which serves as a meeting place and program site for residents and visitors of all ages.

eligibility

The show is open to any living artist submitting work in the following media:

oil
watercolor
drawing
sculpture
acrylic
pastel
mixed media
hand-pulled prints

Photographs, giclée, offset, or computer-generated prints and reproductions are not eligible.

fees

\$15 per entry, limited to 2 entries per artist.

Make checks payable to the Little Compton Community Center; fees are non-refundable.

judges

Joseph Byrne uses oil and watercolor to create still life and landscape art that negotiate description, interpretation, representation and abstraction. He hails from Minnesota and has lived in the Northeast, Italy and Ireland. Joseph has taught at Carleton and Dartmouth Colleges and currently is a professor in the Department of Fine Arts at Trinity College.

Ann Finholt received an MFA from the University of Iowa and an MA in art history from Hunter College. She has worked in the fields of art exhibition organization and writing for shows in New York and Connecticut. Currently her artistic activity is devoted to her studio practice in West Hartford, CT.

requirements

All 2-dimensional entries must be appropriately framed and wired for hanging. Work must not exceed 50" in height and 36" in width including the frame. Sculptures must not exceed 100 pounds, and sculptors are required to supply stands for their art. All art must be priced and available for sale.

smalls

The Art Show will again feature a non-juried exhibit of **smalls**. Each artist entering the show can submit one or two works no larger than 12" square, including frame, in the same media as allowed for the juried works. Framing is optional but works must be suitable for hanging. There are no additional entry fees for the small works. Each **small** is to be priced at \$150 or less, but no commission is taken on the sale so all proceeds go to the artist.

John Willis, printmaker, has received national recognition for his work in the tradition of monotype and monoprint and exhibited in New York, Seattle, Boston and Portland, Maine. John recently retired, having taught relief, monotype and lithography for 30 years at the Hartford Art School.

All food and beverages are to be consumed outdoors (masks not required outdoors). To encourage artist participation, the committee has decided to keep fees and commissions at the 2019 level.

Patrons will be guests at a Preview Party on Friday, August 20, from 5 – 6:30 pm.

awards presentation

There will be a Best in Show (\$200) and four Awards of Excellence (\$100 each) presented. The awards will honor Little Compton artists David Aldrich, Molly Luce Burroughs, Mary Elizabeth Post, and Betty Burroughs Woodhouse. Three Honorable Mention awards will be given, and at the close of the show a People's Choice award (based on public ballots) will be announced.

artists' reception

All artists are invited to a reception on Saturday, August 21, from 5-7pm. Awards will be presented at 6pm.

sales

The Little Compton Community Center will retain a 30% commission (except *smalls*) on all works sold.
