

a juried show

We invite you to participate in our 12th annual Little Compton Summer Art Show at the Little Compton Community Center. Proceeds from this year's show will be used to benefit the many programs at the Center. Located in the beautiful seaside community of Little Compton, Rhode Island, the non-profit Community Center serves as a meeting place and program site for residents and visitors of all ages.

eligibility

The show is open to any living artist submitting work in the following mediums:

oils
acrylics
watercolor
pastels
drawing
mixed media
sculpture
hand-pulled prints

Photographs, offset, or computer-generated prints and reproductions are not eligible.

fees

\$15 per entry, limited to 2 entries per artist.
Make checks payable to the Little Compton Community Center; fees are non-refundable.

requirements

All 2-dimensional entries must be appropriately framed and wired for hanging. **Work must not exceed 50" in height and 36" in width including the frame.** Sculptures must not exceed 100 pounds, and sculptors are required to supply stands for their art. All art must be priced and available for sale.

judges

Harley Bartlett

Harley Bartlett has long admired the American Beaux Arts school of art and architecture and has sought to model his career in that style. His work includes the restoration and creation of large murals in State Houses, theaters, restaurants, churches and private homes, as well as fine art paintings increasingly appreciated by collectors. Harley is a native of Hope, Rhode Island, and was educated at the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts and the University of Pennsylvania. He served apprenticeships with Evergreene Painting Studios and American Illusion. His murals have been featured in magazines including *Interior Design* and *Time*, and his paintings are in many regional galleries.

Marian Brunn Smith

Marian is an accomplished painter who makes images that are dedications to the living, apologies to the dead, and dirges for discarded love. Objects become her words, elements in her paintings are imbued with metaphor. Marian Smith was born in 1980 in Schenectady, NY. She attended Yale University where she received her B.A. in Painting in 2002; in 2007 she received her M.F.A. in Painting from Virginia Commonwealth University. She has had group shows in Connecticut, Massachusetts, Virginia, California and New York City where she currently lives and works.

Sally Whitin

A Providence-based artist and Little Compton summer resident, Sally Whitin is a quilter. She received her B.A. in Fine Arts at New York's SVA and Queens College. "To many, quilting is a delicate and refined task; for me, it is more spontaneous and raw, more about content and less about stitches per inch perfection. I am informed by history, but want to move beyond the limits of craft, trying to find a balance between traditional and modern." Sally's work alludes to earlier styles and conventions, at the same time incorporating her unique imagination, complex forms, and techniques.

awards presentation

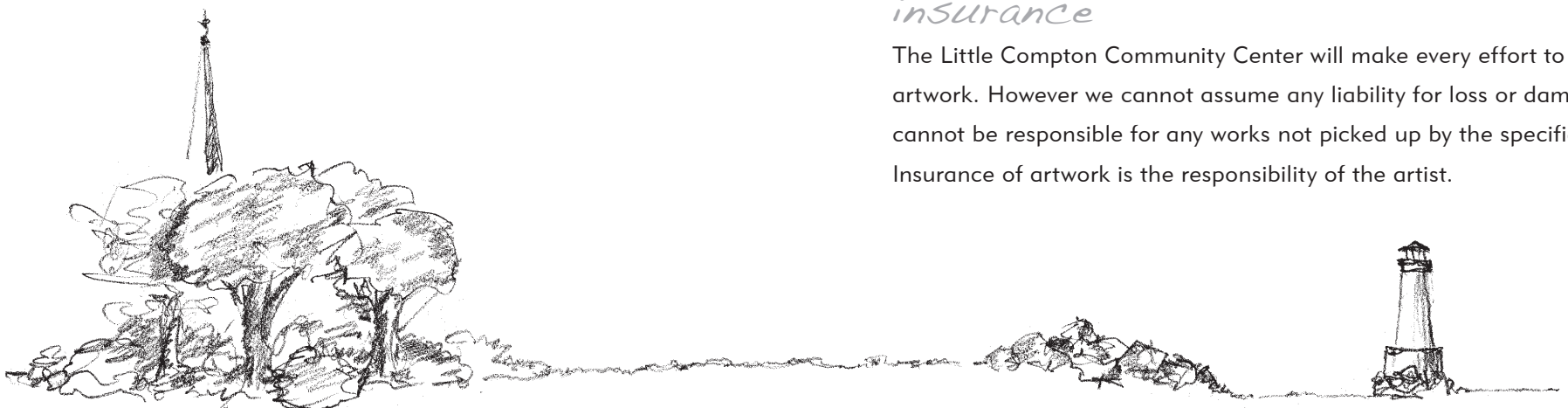

directions

From Boston:
Rt. 93 south to Rt. 24 south to Fall River to Rt. 195 west (about 1 mile) to Rt. 24 south (exit 8A) to Newport. Take exit 5 - Tiverton (Rt. 77), turn left at the end of the exit ramp. Continue south on Rt. 77 through traffic light at Tiverton Four Corners. Approximately 10 miles from the beginning of Rt. 77, there will be a landscaped median triangle, and a green sign with "The Commons" on the right. Turn left at the triangle onto Meeting House Lane and follow the road to the Commons. At the fork in the road, bear left and the Community Center is the shingled building on the left.

From Newport:
Take Rt. 138 and Rt. 24 north toward Fall River. Once over the Sakonnet River Bridge, take the first exit and bear right onto Rt. 77 south to Tiverton/Little Compton. Proceed as above.

From Cape Cod:
Take Rt. 195 west to Fall River to Rt. 24 south (exit 8A) toward Newport. Proceed as above.

From Providence:
Take Rt. 195 east to Fall River to Rt. 24 south (exit 8A) toward Newport. Proceed as above.
